Curriculum

The Peoples Church School-Age Summer curriculum has two foci – Nature and STREAM. STEAM is an acronym for Science, Technology, Respect for nature, Engineering, Art and Mathematics. These activities are combined with daily physical activities and student-led research.

Lesson Plans

Lesson plans will be posted each week in the Parent Information Area. In addition, lesson plans will be sent to parents via email prior to the start of each week.

*Students are welcome to bring their own work or reading materials if they wish, as there are student free choice periods during the day.

This will be a documentation source that shows photos of the students participating in the experiences on the lesson plan.
